

California | Maine's Statement of Faith

We believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. He is the Creator and Sustainer of all things, holy, perfect, and eternally loving.

We believe that the Bible, both Old and New Testaments, is the inspired Word of God, without error in the original writings. It is the ultimate authority for faith and life, revealing God's will for salvation and guiding us in truth.

We believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, fully God and fully man. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, lived a sinless life, died on the cross as the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and rose bodily from the dead. He ascended into heaven and now reigns as Lord, interceding for us and promising to return.

We believe that the Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity, who convicts the world of sin and draws people to Christ. He indwells every believer, guiding, comforting, and empowering them to live a godly life and fulfill their calling in the Kingdom of God.

We believe that all people are created in the image of God but have fallen into sin, separating them from Him. Salvation is a free gift of God's grace, received by faith in Jesus Christ alone. This faith leads to repentance and a life transformed by the Holy Spirit.

We believe in the church, the body of Christ, composed of all true believers. We are called to love one another, serve the world, and make disciples of all nations, sharing the good news of salvation in Jesus Christ.

We believe in the resurrection of the dead and the final judgment. Those who have placed their faith in Christ will spend eternity with Him in heaven, while those who reject Him will face eternal separation from God.

This statement of faith represents the core beliefs that unite us as Christians. We recognize that there may be differences of opinion on secondary matters, but we are committed to working together in love and unity to advance God's Kingdom.
